Matching grant for SMEs for establishment of Industrial Stitching Units

1,000 Industrial Stitching Units (Phase-II) is a PSDP funded project of Ministry of Industries & Production, Government of Pakistan, being executed by Small and Medium Enterprises Development Authority (SMEDA) for provision of matching grants for export development in the country. Phase-II focuses exclusively targeting export-oriented SMEs, already engaged in textile-related exports or those intending to venture into the export market. Matching grants shall be provided on 60:40 ratio and grant size will be upto Rs. 5 million or 60% of the cost of machines, whichever is lower shall be provided by the SMEDA/ISU whereas 40% cost of the machines shall be borne by the SMEs.

1. Grant application forms can be downloaded from the website: www.smeda.org/ISU-form and also available at ISU office mentioned below.
2. Applicant must be a citizen of Pakistan including AJK & GB.
3. Application received without supporting documents/incomplete form and after deadline shall not be accepted.
4. Interested SMEs/Applicants are required to be submitted their grant Applications, duly filled and completed, on/before 30th March 2026 at the following address:
