Our Chairman in Prime Minister's delegation at Pak-China B2B Investment Conference in Beijing

The Pakistan Embassy in Beijing and Pakistan Consulates in Chengdu, Guangzhou, Hong Kong and Shanghai have taken the initiative to organize the 2nd Pakistan-China Business to Business (B2B) Investment Conference in Beijing on 4th September 2025. This high-level Conference built on the momentum generated by its first edition held in June 2024 in Shenzhen city and subsequently B2B roadshows organized in China between October 2024 and January 2025.

Pakistan Embassy in Beijing, Pakistan Consulates in China, Special Investment Facilitation Council, Board of Investment and Ministry of Commerce, Ministry of Industries & Production and other relevant Federal Ministries and Provincial Departments were coordinating preparations for this important Conference.

The Conference featured participation of and day-long B2B networking sessions among 850 Pakistani and Chinese enterprises to explore mutually beneficial investment proposals in nine priority sectors identified by Pakistan including Textile and Apparel.

The Prime Minister of Pakistan led a delegation of Pakistani business dignitaries and our chairman Mr. Mahmood Nara was one of the proud delegates. The Prime Minister presided over and delivered a keynote speech at the opening ceremony. Other key Federal Ministers from Pakistan were also present. Important Senior Chinese dignitaries in the investment and trade circles were also attended and spoke at the Conference.

The opening session featured a video showcasing special incentives for Chinese investors in priority sectors. The opening ceremony was followed by B2B meetings among Pakistani and Chinese enterprises in each sector. On-site interpretation was provided during B2B sessions. Chinese enterprises chose to bring their own interpreter by informing organizers beforehand.

After B2B meetings ended in the afternoon, a closing session was organized in the presence of the Prime Minister at 5 pm to witness announcements and signing of agreements and MoUs.

The leaders of enterprises from both sides as well as other participants were hosted for a dinner after the closing ceremony at the hotel. The Prime Minister of Pakistan also attended that dinner.
